

COVID-19 Testing Now Available On Martha's Vineyard

Please Have Available When Calling for Appointment:

- Insurance provider (carrier & member number)
- If no insurance, you may use your Social Security number
- If no Social Security number, you can still be tested
- Phone number you will answer for test results
- Email address

You must be asymptomatic and 18 years old or older to be tested. This is a COVID-19 test, not an antibody test. If you have symptoms, please call your primary care physician or the triage line at the Martha's Vineyard Hospital at 508-684-4500.

For Your Appointment

- Bring identification
- Wear your mask, do not roll down your window
- A maximum of two people with appointments may come in the same car—the second passenger should be in the back seat behind the driver
- Mobile phone should we need to contact you

The Test

- This is a self-administered swab test observed by a licensed clinician
- You remain in your car
- You will be notified of the results within 24-48 hours
- All insurance providers are required to full cover the test cost
- No one will be turned away because of cost

Your Results

- You will be called whether you test positive or negative
- If positive, you will be called by a contact tracer or your local board of health—please answer all calls with an 833 or 857 area code
- They will need to warn close contacts of exposure, assess symptoms and risk, and provide instructions for next steps. Close contacts should get tested ASAP.
- Regardless of results, all your questions will be answered
